And composts, and raises \$\$ for activities by collecting returnable bottles and cans.

The large dumpster is for normal household waste generated here at the campground. Non-recyclable plastics, pet waste and other usual household trash goes here. Please do not deposit grass clippings and other yard waste here. Parents please do not send small children to dispose of trash — many time the trash needs to be tossed in to the top and small children are not tall or strong enough to lift the lid, leaving trash on the ground around the dumpsters.

The small dumpster is for recycling. Please see the poster on that dumpster for all that should be recycled.

The red cans are for returnable bottles and cans. We collect those for redemption and then use the \$\$ to help keep activity costs down and to build other recreation options.

Composting becomes mandatory in Vermont this summer. Please deposit any vegetable and fruit food waste in the black composter. The side with the green handle is ready for your scraps, the side with the orange on the handle is 'working'. No meat, dairy or pet waste please!

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE

We require that you only use RV Toilet Tissue in your tanks. Our septic systems cannot handle personal wipes (even if they say flushable), paper towels or any other heavy paper product. RV tissue is designed to dissolve rapidly and is better for your tanks as well. Anyone found flushing products other than RV tissue will be charged for the cleaning costs of the septic system.

Please do not place grills, cook tops, or other heat producing items (hot pans, cigarette butts, etc) on the picnic tables. If we find these items on the tables and the tops burned, you will be charged you for a new table top.

Pads are required under all stabilizing equipment (jacks, landing gear, etc). Damage to the grounds by failure to use them will result in a charge for repairing the damage.
